APRIL 3, 2013

Msgr. Pilon opened the meeting with a prayer.

Minutes of the March 6th meeting were reviewed and approved.

There is concern about the 2010 payroll taxes. Call Andrea to make sure that we paid what we were supposed to pay so we aren't ambushed with fees again. There was some concern as to whether the interest on our loan is done quarterly or monthly. If monthly, it would be best if we could get it paid as soon as possible. It was also brought up that it is a very large insurance bill we get in December and it would be nice if we could set up a monthly payment plan rather than having to come up with the money all at once at the end of the year.

The graduation blessing was done too late last year so it will be done earlier this year. Somebody may be bringing cake to celebrate with the graduates. Confirmation for 11th and 12th. Youcat's were purchased for a gift last year and it worked out well so the same will be purchased for this year.

Summer council meetings-Meetings are more difficult during the summer due to people working long hours and being out of town. The May, July, and August meetings will be skipped this summer.

Looked at a sample sign that was made. It was very nice and approved by the council at 3x5. The cost will be \$160.00 plus the cost of cedar posts. The sign will need to be shown to Mrs. Kuble for final approval. David and Al will put up the sign when it arrives. Sam to ask Matthew to see if he wants to continue with the lawn care. More downspouts need to be added to the north side of the building. Al to check on it. More rock is left and it was suggested that it be dumped on the east side once it dries up.

Holy week schedule- Any modifications? Holy Thursday did not work at 5:30 at OLP. Maybe switch to 7 or 7:30pm if St. Agnes would be willing to have the 5:30 service. Or possibly not do it at all.

There are thoughts of doing a fall supper again. Maybe 4-7 on a Sunday with possible delivery options if we can get volunteers to drive them to where they need to go. We will maybe cut the craft show or cookie walk or do them together. We would like to see more community building activities without them being fundraisers. The first weekend in June is VBS. We could possibly have a "summerfest" after VBS is over so hopefully more people come. Or have a Sunday Mass and start right after that. Sam and Mary to think about it and get it going if it will work out.

We would like people to be more thankful and appreciative of each other and make sure that things are being put in the bulletin when we are having volunteers help out with things. Will really help people feel better about helping out.
