**MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR
CONJUGAL LOVE**

The Catholic Catechism of the Church teaches that conjugal love is a totality. All the elements of the human person come together not just as a sum but as a complete whole. These elements include the appeal of the body and instincts as well as the power of feelings and affectivity, i.e., the results of emotions and affections. Another element is the aspirations or hopes of the spirit and the will. The will refers to the decision making aspect of a person. Conjugal love aims at a deeply personal unity, a unity beyond union in one flesh. Conjugal love aims at forming one heart and soul. In order to develop this unity indissolubility and faithfulness are required in mutual giving. This unity of heart and soul is open to fertility as an expression of love. The normal characteristics of natural love take on a new significance which not only purifies and strengthens the couple but raises them to becoming the expression of specifically Christian values.

Through the unity and indissolubility of conjugal love, Christian spouses form a community of persons which is inclusive of their entire love. Christian spouses are called to grow through their day-to-day fidelity to their marriage promise of total mutual self-giving. The human community of marital love is confirmed, purified and completed by communion in Jesus Christ given to them in the Sacrament of Matrimony. They deepen their communion with Christ by living common faith and through reception of the Eucharist.

By its very nature conjugal love requires the inviolable fidelity of the spouses. Love seeks to be definitive; it cannot be arranged until further notice. The intimate union of marriage, as a mutual giving of two persons, and the good of the children demand total fidelity from the spouses and require an unbreakable union between them.

The deepest reason for this is the fidelity of God to his covenant, in Christ to his Church. In the sacrament of Matrimony the spouses are enabled to represent the fidelity of God and Christ and witness to it. Conjugal love is the living proclamation of the Good News that God loves us with a definitive and irrevocable love. Spouses, who with God's grace give this witness, often in very difficult conditions, deserve the gratitude and support of the ecclesial community.

Upcoming Community Events


