

MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR MARY MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

Pope Francis on March 3 has just established the day to celebrate the teaching that the Blessed Virgin Mary is the Mother of the Church. The Monday after Pentecost has been established as the day each year to celebrate the Memorial that Mary is the Mother of the Church. Memorial is a technical term describing the importance of the celebration. The levels are Solemnity with the obligation to attend Mass, Solemnity, Feast, Memorial and optional Memorial. These rankings have to do with choosing the celebration to be recognized at Mass. If there happens to be a saint whose celebration is ranked as a Feast, the celebration of the Mass for the saint would take priority over a Memorial or Optional Memorial.

Although recognizing this teaching with a celebration in the Roman Calendar is new, the concept is ancient. It has a scriptural basis when Jesus entrusts His mother to the Beloved Disciple. The beloved disciple is often thought to be John, the author of the Gospel in which this title appears. It seems to also have a greater significance. The Beloved Disciple is the faithful Christian committed to Christ.

Historically, the teaching that Mary is the mother of Jesus who is both God and human leads to the recognition that she is the mother of God. We also believe that the Church is the Body of Christ. Since Jesus is the Christ, the Head of the Body, Mary is understood to be the mother of the Church. She is the mother of the whole Body of Christ, not just the head.

More recent developments in recognizing the importance of Mary to the Church came at the end of the Second Vatican Council. At this Council Blessed Paul VI declared "the Blessed Virgin Mary as 'Mother of the Church, that is to say of all Christian people, the faithful as well as the pastors, who call her the most loving Mother.'" Pope Francis has emphasized many times the importance of Mary in the church, leading up to this decision to establish this official Memorial celebration.

PROTECT HUMAN LIFE


