**MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR
GRADUATES**

Today we will be honoring our high school graduates. We give glory and praise to God that He has protected and blessed each of you during this time of formation. Now you look forward to a more directed time of training. For some this could be a relatively short period of time, maybe a couple of years, others may be looking towards several years, especially if you are looking towards a Master's or Doctoral degree. During this time of transition you will be moving towards an adult relationship with God. In adulthood you have choices to make. Do you believe in a God who cares so much for you that He first gives His life for you on a Cross and who upon being raised from the dead sends His Holy Spirit to guide and protect you?

There are many who say they believe but choose not to develop a friendship with God. They choose not to be closely connected with God and His people. They seem to assume that through some general osmosis God will fill them with meaning and eternal life. Rather than try to get closer to God they get wrapped up in the attractions of the world. FINANCIAL STATEMENT

At the Parish Council there was some discussion that parishioners should be kept regularly informed about the financial status of the parish. This can be difficult to find the right balance between too little and too much information. We had spoken of giving a monthly report of the income and the expense. At first I was thinking of giving each month separately, but I think giving a year to date of actual income and expense might be more useful. So for the year to date the income has been \$41,065.94 and the expense has been \$ 36,731.69. An unexpected expense we had in March was the water heater for the kitchen and bathrooms sprung a leak. We replaced it with a tankless on demand

water heater that cost \$3650.45. This may be more expensive upfront but in long run should save money since it only heats water when in use. The other major expense was addition of anti-freeze to the wells for the geothermal system which cost \$1037.50. If you would ever like a more detailed report, just ask. I can print out or email reports all the way down to individual checks., if needed. On the accordion door in the classroom we have decided to go with a bifold door which should cost around \$600.

Do you know how to recognize the warning signs of a stroke?
