**MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR
TRINITY SUNDAY**

The Trinity is a teaching that is beyond real understanding. We are trying to describe God who is beyond description. We are speaking about the One who created the universe, who created space and time. As Creator of all these things, God lives outside them. We cannot even imagine what this means.

Source of this teaching is from simple fact. God wants us to be more than mere creatures. He loves His creation so much that He wants us to know and love Him in return. He has chosen to gradually reveal Himself to us, first in creations itself then in the revelation given to us in the scriptures. We describe this revelation happening by the Holy Spirit inspiring the human authors of Sacred Scripture so that they reveal God's actions on our behalf.

When we try to communicate with each other about ourselves, we use words to reveal our thoughts and feelings. We have no other way of truly sharing with another person or even ourselves who we are. We often struggle to find the right words to describe ourselves or our feelings. We never seem to be able to find the right words or enough words to fully describe ourselves.

In a sense this is not a problem for God. The Word He speaks reveals everything about who He is. This Word so perfectly describes God and reveals His thoughts and feelings, that the Word is God Himself. God who chooses to reveal Himself is the Father, the source of revelation. God who is the Word being spoken, the revelation of God is so complete that it is God Himself in the Son.
