MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR FATHER'S DAY

Thinking about Father's Day I thought I might emphasize some insights from the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The Catechism notes that the fatherhood of God is the source of human fatherhood. This is the foundation of the honor owed to fathers. Respect for fathers flows from the gratitude towards those who by the gift of life, their love and their work, have brought their children into the world and enabled them to grow in stature, wisdom and grace.

The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit. In the procreation and education of children the Christian family reflects the Father's work of creation. The family is called to partake of the prayer and sacrifice of Christ. Daily prayer and reading of the Word of God strengthens it in charity.

Relationships within the family bring a like-mindedness of feeling, affections and interest which arise from the members' respect for one another. The family is a privileged community called to achieve a sharing of thought and common deliberation by the spouses as well as their eager cooperation as parents in the children's upbringing.

Fathers are an image of God as well as of the First Person of the Trinity. Many religions have invoked God as "Father". In Israel God was considered "Father" first as Creator of the world. They also saw God as Father because He gave them the covenant and the gift of the law. God is the true Father as He is the first origin of everything. Through His loving care He maintains a parental tenderness for His creation. Jesus reveals God as Father by proclaiming Himself as the Son. As the Son Jesus is the full revelation of God's love for the world being willing to sacrifice Himself totally for the world.

On this Father's Day we honor our fathers who by their lives, though imperfectly, provide a symbol of God's love. Fathers reveal God in their willingness to sacrifice themselves for their families in the image of the One true Father.
