MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

SHEEP WITHOUT A SHEPHERD

We live in busy, noisy times. In contrast I think of my days in seminary when we were allowed only one hour of TV and any radio would be confiscated. We were supposed to be dedicated to our studies. Over time media has grown, it seems, exponentially. We went from radios to stereos to iPods to Smartphones. We communicate not just by phone and mail but by email, instant messaging and text messaging. The internet originally was mostly bulletin boards and short comments. Then the Web developed with many browsers to choose from. Now there is social media like FaceBook, Twitter and it seems more are developing nearly every day.

All of these forms of communication are calling for our attention. Each of them suggests that we will benefit if we participate in them. To get our attention each has to propose a slightly different message. When we hear multiple messages that sometimes complement each other, at other time contradict each other or disagree about the importance of a different message, it becomes hard to know who or what should we pay attention to. We become like sheep facing many gates each with an enticing pasture, milling around trying to decide which gate we should enter.

The motto of the VA Medical Foster Home program is ‘Where Heroes Meet Angels.’ The program provides long term care for disabled Veterans who prefer a family setting over a nursing home. The program partners with people with caregiving experience, who live within a 50 mile radius of Fargo and who have extra room in their homes and their hearts. Medical Foster Home Caregivers would take in up to three Veterans and provide their ongoing care and supervision. The home must meet the VA’s fire and safety requirements and will be inspected by a VA team before approval. The VA Home Based Primary Care team comes into the home to provide medical case management to the Veteran. The Veteran pays the caregiver a monthly rate based on the care level needed.
