MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

EUCHARISTIC PRAYERS

A few weeks ago presented an explanation about the introductions to the Eucharistic Prayer called the Preface. As I mentioned then there are many Prefaces each having its own focus on a reason why we give thanks to God on this day. Every Preface concludes with the glorious acclamation of the Sanctus or Holy, Holy. Now we join the heavenly host, led by the priest, offering the gifts of bread and wine presented during the Preparation of the Gifts. During this prayer there are several common elements of giving and receiving between us and our God. Before I discuss these various elements, want to note that there are several Eucharistic Prayers.

Between the Council of Trent and Vatican II a period of about four hundred years, there was only one Eucharistic Prayer in the Latin rite of the Catholic Church. This had traditionally been known as the Roman Canon. The word "Canon" has the sense of being a unified body of principles. The Church law is known as Canon Law because each canon contains a set of principles or laws. In the liturgy the Canon of the Mass was the body of

prayerful words and gestures that give praise to God.

Since the Vatican II reform of the liturgy the Church has approved several additional Eucharistic Prayers. The first to be approved, besides the Roman Canon now called Eucharistic Prayer I, were prayers II, III and IV. These are the most commonly used and are the ones most often printed in hymnals. Eucharistic Prayers II and IV have their own Preface attached to the prayer. The Preface for Eucharistic Prayer II may be exchanged for another Preface. The Preface for Eucharistic Prayer IV is intimately connected to the theme of the Prayer and so must always be used with this Prayer.
