**MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR
DOMESTIC CHURCH**

The first reading today is a hymn to the good wife. It is a reminder to men who live in a patriarchal society that they should not take their families and especially their wives for granted. It is a challenge to every husband to recognize that the value of his wife is not in charm and fleeting beauty but in her commitment to the family.

The value of family is often forgotten in society. The primary value that society places on people is that they must be either producers or consumers. Family life is made secondary to the principles of commerce and profit.

The Church especially at the Second Vatican Council points out that more important than issues of economy is the sacredness of family life. It describes the family as being a "Domestic Church". It notes that Christ Himself chose to be born within the family of Joseph and Mary. The Church itself sees itself as best described as the family of God. As the Catholic Catechism reminds us it is within the family that the members exercise the priesthood of the baptized. A family helps bring its members to holiness through the reception of the sacraments, prayer, thanksgiving, the witness of a holy life, self-denial and active charity. Within the family one learns endurance, the joy of work, fraternal love, generous forgiveness. Above all a family participates in divine worship by prayer and offering one's life to the family.
