**MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR  
CREED (cont.)**

**He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end**

These words of the Creed remind us that we are living in the end times. The study of the end times is often described as eschatology. In Christian theology there are two words for time taken from the Greek. These words are *chronos* and *kairos*. Chronos is the source word for chronology. It refers to the ordinary sequence of time that can be measured by the clock. Kairos refers to the in between, moments that have special meaning. These are moments in which we are able to experience the movement of God's Spirit within the world. Kairos is the purpose of worship, to be freed from the tyranny of the inevitable march of time that we feel in ordinary life. Kairos has the sense of celebration and freedom.

We are invited to look forward to the fullness of Kairos. People sometimes talk about being "in the zone". This is the feeling that everything is going just right. We lose track of time, totally absorbed the joy of what we are doing. Jesus will come to bring about His kingdom where full excitement will totally absorb our attention.

In our culture judging has an ominous feel to it. We think of judges as person with the authority to punish us and take away our freedom. Jesus as judge becomes a fearful figure. The Old Testament vision of judge is much more hopeful. Before Israel had kings they depended on God raising up Judges to save them from oppression. The role of the Judge was to be a leader and savior from those oppressing Israel. Jesus when He comes in glory will be a Judge who will lead us out of the slavery of sin and free us from our guilt and shame. He will declare us holy having been washed in His blood.

Because we are so tied to chronological time we think of this happening some time in the future. But in God's time, the kairos, this is happening all around us. We sometimes get a glimpse of this when we let go of this world. Sometimes in prayer or in the sacraments we can experience mystical moments when the presence of God suddenly becomes evident to us. It is a challenge to let go of chronological time and give ourselves over to God. It is a skill that comes in quieting our mind and allowing God to speak to us. In these moments we enter into the kairos and discover the wonders of love expressed in Jesus.

## ***Safety Tips***

How you stop on ice depends on what kind of brakes your vehicle has. If you have anti-lock brakes, apply a firm and continuous pressure. Pumping anti-lock brakes decreases their effectiveness because it turns the system off and on. If you don't have anti-lock brakes than you should pump them by pressing them fully on then fully off.
