MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. An unfortunate reality of Christian practice as opposed to Christian faith is that the Easter Season tends to get downplayed. We make a big effort to express our repentance during Lent. Easter is meant to be a glorious celebration of God's love and mercy. Jesus has risen. He has conquered death and sin. He is giving us the gift of freedom and peace. In the Gospel He breathes the Holy Spirit on the early Church promising true peace and life. It is interesting that doubt is an essential aspect of Jesus' first appearance to His disciples. Thomas is not present and does not believe that Jesus is alive. Perhaps that same doubt is behind our paying less attention to our faith during the Easter season. It is very easy to recognize our failures and weaknesses during the Lenten season. To believe and open our lives to the gift of the Holy Spirit in Easter requires real faith. It requires faith because it is not something we can do to make it happen. It is a totally free gift of God, an expression of His love for us. He has chosen to wash away all our sins. The Divine Mercy image expresses this mystery. Rays come out from Jesus heart representing water and blood. Water and Blood symbolize the sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist by which Jesus unites us to His death and resurrection. Jesus takes the initiative to cleanse us from our impurities to make us one with the Trinity. This is a mystery that is challenging to accept. Our very beings are washed clean so that we are worthy of becoming one with God. God is inviting us to become His beloved children. He makes us holy, not by our effort but by His own. He promises us a life beyond imagining. This is some of the mystery of God's love expressed by Divine Mercy Sunday.
