The day's events will begin with Holy Mass at Noon, Cathedral of St. Mary, 604 Broadway, Fargo. This will be followed by a prayerful, peaceful procession to the state's only abortion facility. A short prayer service will be held outside the abortion facility, and then those gathered will return to the Cathedral for Benediction. A lunch will be served by the Cardinal Muench Council Knights of Columbus in the church social hall after Benediction. Cost for the lunch is \$5/person. Father's Prayer Intentions for September

Value of Silence. That people today, often overwhelmed by noise, may rediscover the value of silence and listen to the voice of God and their brothers and sisters.

Persecuted Christians. That Christians suffering persecution in many parts of the world may by their witness be prophets of Christ's love.

MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR

BEFORE THE PRAYER OVER THE OFFERINGS

Following the washing of the hands the liturgy moves from preparing the gifts towards the high point of the Mass, the Eucharistic prayer. The new translation emphasizes that the priest is about to act in the person of Christ. In the old translation the priest asked the people to pray that *our* sacrifice be acceptable to God the almighty father. In the new translation the priest prays that *my sacrifice and yours* may be acceptable. The new translation emphasizes the theological note from Vatican II that there is a distinct difference between the ministerial priesthood of the ordained and the common priesthood of the baptized. The translation also emphasizes that there are different roles that are to be expressed in the liturgy. In the ideal world envisioned by the liturgy deacons, acolytes and lectors each would play a role. For example the deacon has the authority to proclaim the gospel and to preach. Someone installed as an acolyte has the responsibility of distributing communion while the installed lector has the right to proclaim the scriptures other than the gospel.

In the less than ideal world of many parishes some roles get blended. The baptized may be delegated to proclaim the readings and to serve as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. The priest in addition to presiding over the liturgy also carries out the diaconal role.

Before the people make their response: "*May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church,*" they are to rise so that they are standing as they make this prayer. The posture of standing for this response serves to remind us of the exodus. The Israelites were told to eat the Passover meal standing in readiness to flee Egypt and begin their journey to the Promised Land. We stand to show our readiness to enter into the sacramental journey and pray that the sacrifice be accepted. We are now ready to begin the transition into the Eucharistic prayer with the Prayer over the Offerings.

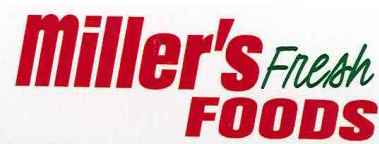

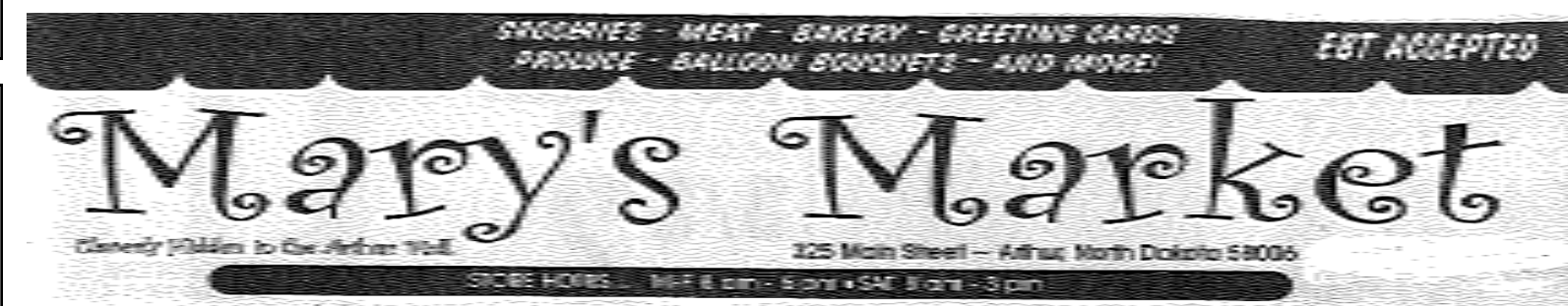
